- *Dormitory fee is ¥25,000 per months . (Not included electricity Gas & Water charge). Pay rent monthly for six months from September 2020 to February 2021(Payment deadline is the last day of each previous months)
- XIf there are relatives of applicants residing in Japan, under the following conditions, living together with relatives in Japan shall be permitted after coming to Japan.
 - ① If the relatives is foreigner, who residing in japan, He/she had stay in Japan for more than a year with possession of status of residence, and be able to communicate in Japanese.
 - ② The residence of relatives in Japan who plan to live together is within the range that does not interfere with attending to our school.
 - ③ At the time of application, "yes" should be entered in the "To live together" column in the "In-Japan relatives" section of the application for admission
 - ④ Have submitted all the following documents for all relatives in Japan who plan to live together (Not necessary if it overlaps with Documents of list of documents submitted on page 2)
 - 1. Resident's card copy (If you are a foreign national, copy the residence card)
 - 2. Documents to know where you go to school or work (Example: Student ID copy, Certificate of employment)
 - 3. Documents to prove kinship with the applicant
 - (5) If there is a change in the presence or absence of living plans after the application, please contact the school by February 28, 2020.
 - (6) At (5), If you wish to change to a living together, submit all documents concerning ④ by the above-mentioned time limit. Despite not meet the above conditions, if you wish to change to a living together, as a cancellation fee, you must pay 5 months for admission and housing costs to the

<u>school</u>(If the first dormitory fee has been paid, the amount excluding the entry fee and the dormitory fee for 5 months is refunded.)
